

OHSET COVID GUIDELINES

	General Guidelines
	Follow ALL guidance from OSAA, OHA, ODE, and member school districts
	Member schools must follow these guidelines in addition to their own school district guidelines
	The strictest guidelines supersede others
Face Coverings	Will be required at all times indoors AND will be required at all times outdoors when social distancing space of 6 feet cannot be maintained
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All spectators will wear a mask or face covering whether inside or outside in accordance with the Statewide Mask, Face Covering, Face Shield Guidance https://sharesystems.dhsoha.state.or.us/DHSForms/Served/le2288K.pdf
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coaches will be required to wear a mask at all times, unless able to maintain social distancing of 6 feet from any other person in an outdoor space
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Athletes are not required to wear a mask when outside, assuming social distancing of 6 feet between persons can be maintained
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Athletes will be required to wear a mask at all times when indoors, even when horseback
Hand Hygiene	Practice good hand hygiene
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wash hands frequently with soap and water, preferred, or hand sanitizer that contains 60-95% alcohol
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hand Sanitizer (containing 60-95% alcohol) will be available at all events Encourage athletes to bring their own sanitizer to all events
Contact Tracing/Symptom Tracker	Maintain a contact tracer report , taking attendance and screening for symptoms at each practice
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All persons at the event will take own temperature prior to arrival at event/practice and assess self for symptoms related to COVID 19 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperature should be below 100.4 degrees F
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Upon arrival to the practice/event, all persons will check in at the designated checkpoint Coaches/Advisors will conduct a visual scan of each individual, checking for any symptoms of COVID-19 Coaches/Advisors will complete a Contact Tracer form for every person in attendance at each event
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants should be, at a minimum, 48 hours symptom free before attending any event
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants must self-report to the Team Coach/Advisor if they develop symptoms within 14 days after the event/practice
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All coaches, advisors, athletes, spectators/guardians who have signs or symptoms of illness are to stay home when ill to decrease the risk of viral transmission

OHSET COVID GUIDELINES

Cleaning and Disinfecting	Frequently clean and disinfect high traffic areas, and commonly touched surfaces in areas accessed by staff, athletes and spectators
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coaches/Advisors/Designated Person will be responsible for cleaning • Cleaning solutions

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Utilize a bleach spay solution (1/3c bleach to 1 gallon water)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Other commercially prepared cleaning agents are acceptable as well, such as Clorox, Fantastik, Lysol ○ Follow directions on product label
	Avoid or minimize equipment sharing
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When it is necessary to share equipment, all surfaces of each piece of shared equipment must be cleaned and disinfected in between athlete uses and prior to storage
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coaches/designated person will be required to do the cleaning of shared team equipment
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Utilize cleaning products as directed above
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gate Person is the only person to open and close the gate. Sanitize gate before and after event or if changing assigned gate person
Food	Absolutely no sharing of food or drinks at any time
	Individually wrapped/packaged food is acceptable
Travel	Encourage those only in the same household to travel together
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If carpooling with others outside your household occurs, everyone must wear face coverings and spread out as much as possible
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limit travel groups to those who have been in regular contact

OHSET COVID GUIDELINES

	Meet Guidelines (in addition to General Guidelines)
	Follow ALL guidance from OSAA, OHA, ODE, and member school districts; including guidance to suspend or cancel meets due to a virus outbreak
	Member schools must follow these guidelines in addition to their own school district guidelines
	Follow OHSET General Guidelines listed previously in this document
Spectators	Limit spectators to comply with OHA guidance of limiting event gatherings to no more than 250 total persons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For example, may need to limit spectators to one or two per athlete to keep event gathering below the 250 total persons limit
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All spectators will wear a mask or face covering when inside and outside in accordance with the Statewide Mask, Face Covering, Face Shield Guidance https://sharesystems.dhsoha.state.or.us/DHSForms/Served/le2288K.pdf
	Spectators will check in and out at the designated space upon arrival and departure each day
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will be assessed for symptoms
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If symptom free will be given a wristband identifying they've been checked in. Wristband to be worn for that assigned day
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will be documented on the COVID 19 Tracer Report
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must self-report to the District designated person if they develop symptoms during or within 14 days after the Meet
	Spectators should adhere to social distancing guidelines when viewing events
Volunteers and Judges	Follow mask and face covering guidelines as listed above
	Adhere to social distancing guidelines
	Volunteers
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sanitize pens, clipboards, etc between each volunteer/event
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gate Person is the only person to open and close the gate. Sanitize gate before and after event or if changing assigned gate person
	Judges
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No Judges FOOD provided Allow time for them to go off location to get food Add a food stipend within the contract
	Office Space
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sanitize space, desks, etc before and after use of shared spaces
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit number of persons in office space dependent on square footage of space
Athletes	Follow mask and face covering guidelines as listed above
	Adhere to social distancing guidelines at all times, especially when in barn areas
	Athletes will check in and out at the designated space upon arrival and departure each day
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will be assessed for symptoms
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If symptom free will be given a wristband identifying they've been checked in. Wristband to be worn for that assigned day
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will be documented on the COVID 19 Tracer Report

Athletes (cont.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must self-report to the District designated person and the Individual Team Coach or Advisor if they develop symptoms during or within 14 days after the Meet
Events	All events will be offered
	Shared Equipment Events
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment will be sanitized between athletes
	See Cleaning and Disinfecting in General Guidelines
Stall Areas	Adhere to social distancing guidelines at all times and follow mask and face covering guidance as listed previously
	No group gatherings of any kind
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limit number of persons in stall areas to adequately maintain social distancing requirements
	Absolutely no sharing of food or drinks at any time
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All food must be individually wrapped food (homemade or store bought)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sanitize hands immediately prior to selecting food
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limit number of persons at/around any food areas to adequately maintain social distancing requirements
	No sharing of any equipment
Camping on site	Encourage those only in the same household or designated pod to stay together
	Encourage those that don't need to stay on-site to choose other overnight accommodations
